The deadline to submit an application for **Fall 2017** and receive a registration date and time is **July 6**.

Students applying after this date will register during open registration.

## BOG Fee Waiver

The Board of Governor's Fee Waiver (BOGW) is a state funded aid program that waives the enrollment fee for income eligible California residents. Students may apply for the BOGW one of two ways:

- Submit a FAFSA (<https://fafsa.ed.gov>) or a California Dream Act Application (<https://dream.csac.ca.gov>), or
- Apply for the BOGW in person at the Financial Aid Office during the application window (application window is three weeks prior to the start of the semester up to census, please consult the academic calendar).
