Classes are transferable to four-year institutions. Check with a counselor for details. Easy, on-campus parking with permit, \$35 in the Cashier's Office, 619-388-4886. Application and registration is the same for ECC classes as it is for other City College classes.

ECC is easily accessible. Off 805 south, take the Imperial Ave. Exit, west to 45th. Turn left. Go to the stop sign at Ocean View Blvd. Turn right. Half a block up on the left-hand side you will see the campus in a beautiful park-like setting.
