Application and registration is the same for Educational Cultural Complex classes as it is for other City College classes.

The Educational Cultural Complex is easily accessible. Off 805 south, take the Imperial Ave. Exit, west to 45th. Turn left. Go to the stop sign at Ocean View Blvd. Turn right. Half a block up on the left-hand side you will see the campus in a beautiful park-like setting.

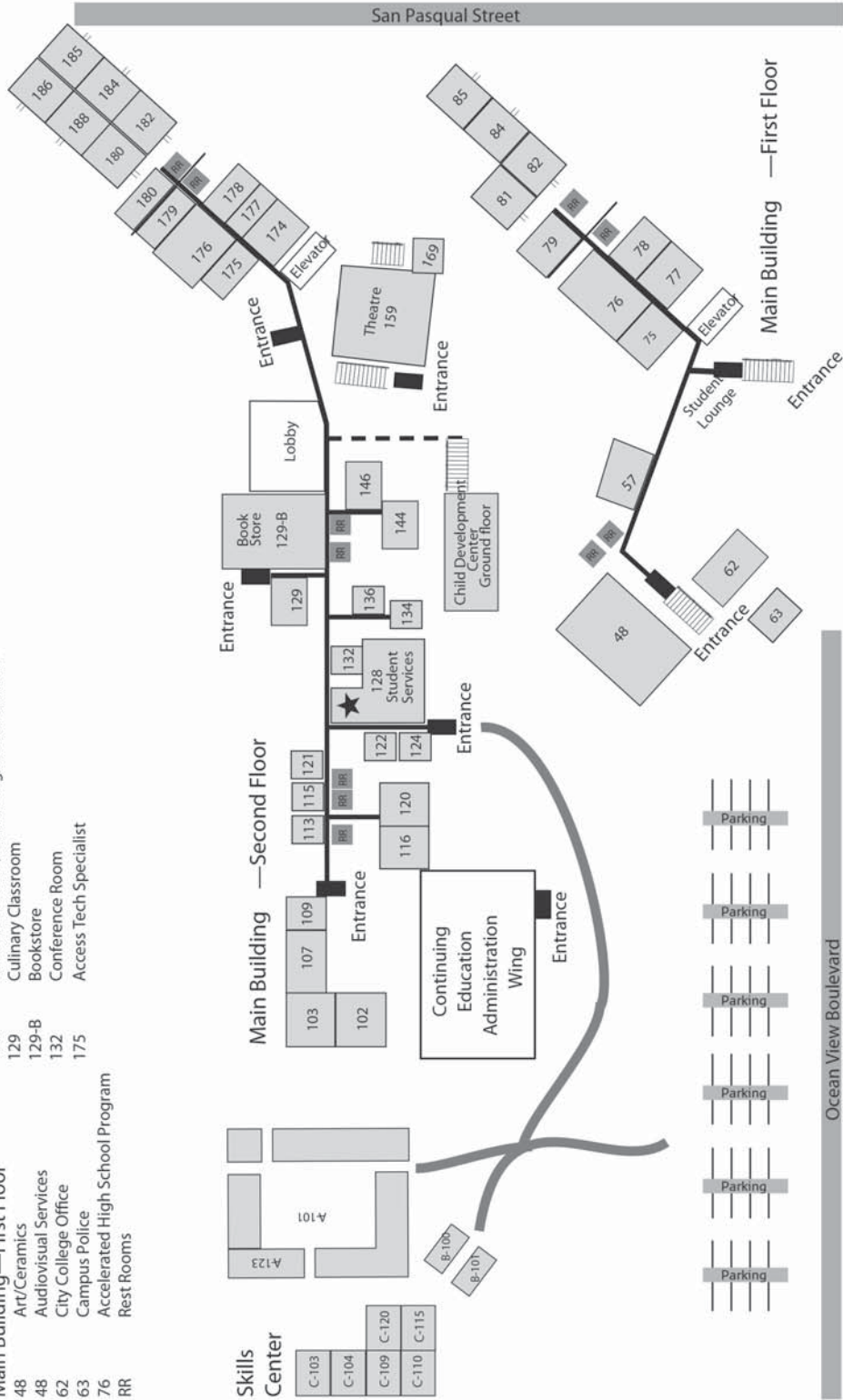
