# **Disability Access Information for Graduation**

## Graduates with Disabilities

Graduates with disabilities that need disability related accommodations for the graduation ceremony should complete this online <a href="Accommodation Request for Graduates Form">Accommodation Request for Graduates Form</a> by <a href="May 10">May 10</a>, <a href="2019">2019</a> for mobility assistance, an American Sign Language interpreter, or other accommodations. You may also contact the DSPS office for additional information.

#### Guests with Disabilities

There will be a section with reserved accessible seating located in the convention center ballroom. The seating is available on a first come first serve basis so it is advised that any guests needing accessible seating arrive early. Access will be given to the guest with a disability plus 1 additional guests. Once the section is **FULL** it will be closed. **Please advise your guest to arrive early if they are needing accessible seating.** 

Sign Language Interpreters will be on stage for graduation at the Convention Center and will be video casted on the screens visible throughout. There will also be a limited amount of seats reserved for Deaf Guests in the accessible seating area. Please arrive early for optimal seating.

# Accessible Parking

Candidates or guests with State of California disabled parking permits may park in any legal stall in Convention Center Parking Lot. There are a limited number of accessible spaces reserved in each of the parking lots.

If you are a guest or graduate with a significant mobility limitation, there will be a designated drop off location at Front Drive in which wheelchair transport will be available.
