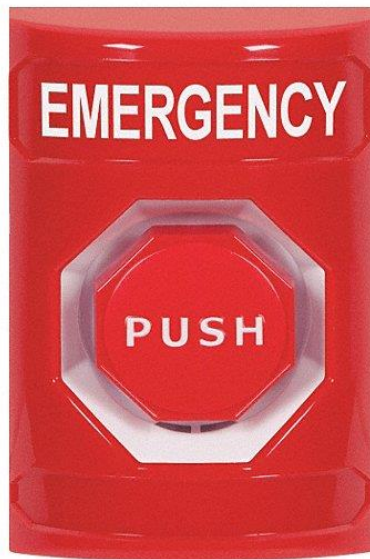

- Clearing bushes for safety

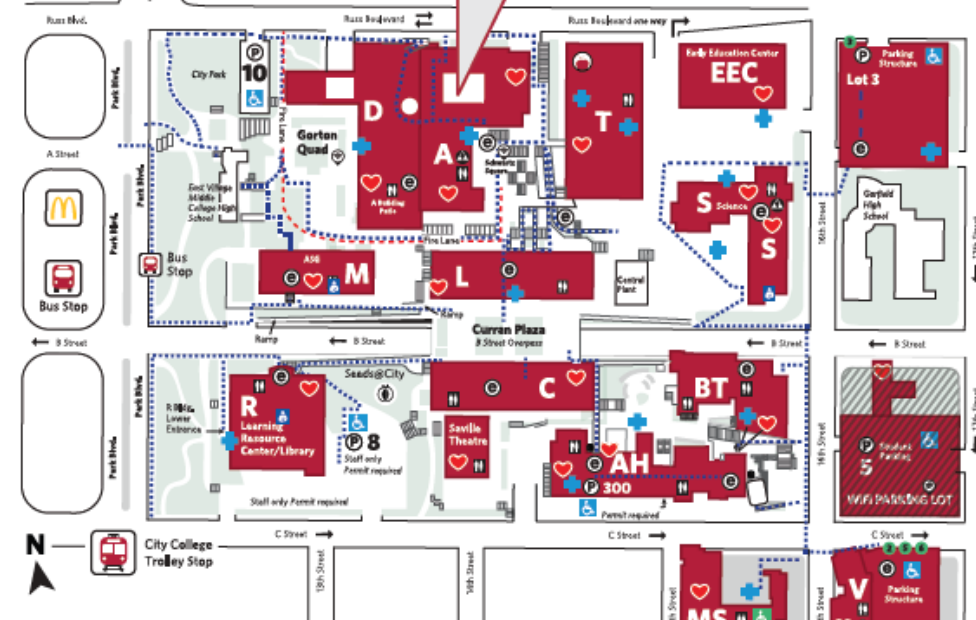
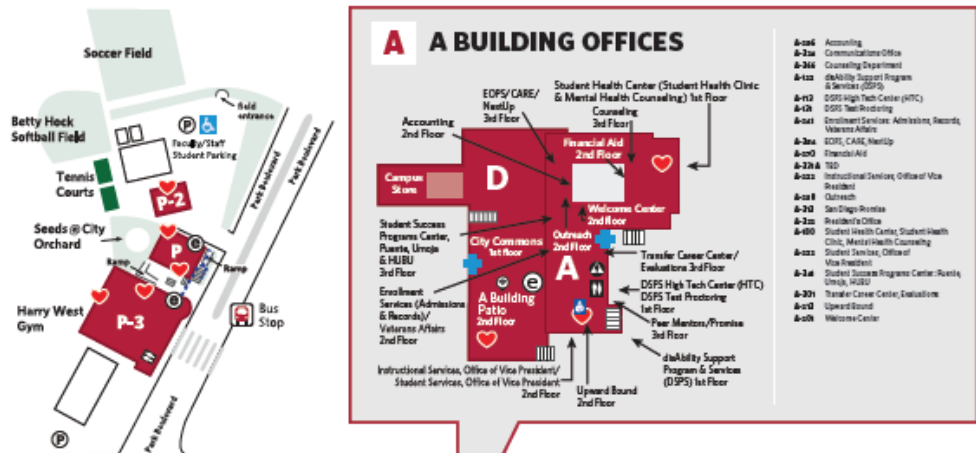

OPERATING YOUR FIRE EXTINGUISHER



PULL THE PIN



AIM AT THE BASE



SQUEEZE TRIGGER



SWEEP

Remember:

- Test extinguisher before approaching the fire
- Keep low & approach with the wind at your back
- Back away, watching for rekindle

SAFE WALKING

- **30,000 cellphone-related injuries from walking, between 2011-19**
- **53% occur at home**
- **55% <40 years old**
- **Results in sprains, dislocations, fractures, and concussions.**

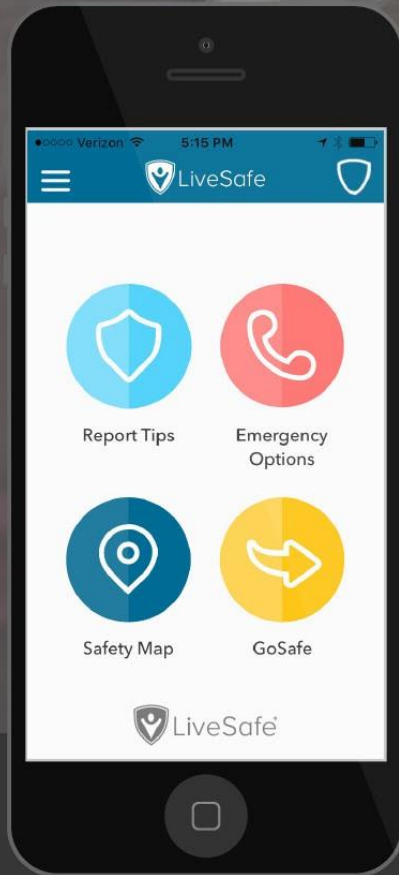

WHY?

- AVERAGE OF 20 INCIDENTS PER YEAR
- ACTIVE SHOOTER INCIDENTS OCCUR UNPREDICTABLY
- AGAINST RANDOM VICTIMS
- BY A SINGLE SHOOTER
- IN A TIME SPAN OF 4-10 MINUTES
- POLICE RESPONSE TIME: AVERAGE 5 MINUTES

RUN-HIDE-FIGHT

INDIVIDUALS PREPARE MENTALLY AND PHYSICALLY TO TAKE A LEADERSHIP POSITION THAT WILL INCREASE THE CHANCES OF SURVIVAL FOR THEMSELVES, AND OTHERS FACED WITH AN ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION.

Rape Aggression Defense

A FREE PROGRAM OFFERED TO STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF. THIS PROGRAM IS A COURSE THAT TEACHES AWARENESS, PREVENTION, RISK REDUCTION AND AVOIDANCE, WHILE PROGRESSING ON TO THE BASICS OF HANDS-ON DEFENSE TRAINING.
