Study abroad in BARCELONA

PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Round-trip airport transfers: one-time transfer between airport (BCN) and housing on the scheduled arrival and departure dates
- Accommodation in a local homestay in twin rooms with shared living space and bathrooms. Linens and Wi-Fi are provided and weekly laundry service is included
- Continental breakfast and dinner daily with the homestay family
- An orientation program on arrival, consisting of a meeting with AIFS staff, information on safety and security and cultural differences, a local area walking tour, and a welcome dinner
- Travel pass (T-Usual) for unlimited use of the metro, buses, trams and regional trains in the central zone of Barcelona for the duration of the program
- Half-day cultural tour of Barcelona by bus with the services of a professional, English-speaking guide
- Cultural activities including entrance to the Parc Güell, a Modernism themed walking tour, entrance and guided tour of the Sagrada familia, and a guided tour of the Picasso Museum
- An Art-ticket, granting one entrance to six Barcelona museums
- A Spanish cooking class

- Full-day excursion to Girona and Figueres, including guided walking tour of the historic center of Girona and entrance to a self-guided visit to Teatro Museo Dalí and round-trip transportation
- Full day excursion to Tarragona, including guided walking tour of the historical center including entrance to the Roman Forum, Amphitheater and Praetorian Tower and round-trip transportation
- Access to the AIFS Student Center and the services of AIFS support staff for information, personal advising, and 24-hour emergency contact service
- A Flamenco show
- A farewell dinner
- Medical Insurance

COURSES

Spanish 102 Second Course in Spanish

5 hours lecture, 5 units

Prerequisite: Spanish 101 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent, or two years of high school Spanish with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent.

Spanish 210 Conversation and Composition

Spanish I - 3 hours lecture, 3 units

Prerequisite: Spanish 102 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent.

FEES

Based on an enrollment of 20+ students, the fee per person is \$3275.

This fee excludes airfare, passport or visa fees, meals other than those listed, personal expenses, any San Diego City College tuition or administrative fees, textbooks, additional field trips or excursions required by the San Diego City College faculty and anything not specified.
